

## The Mícheál Ó Cléirigh Prize

The UCD Mícheál Ó Cléirigh Institute is a leading research institute in the field of Irish studies. It was founded in 2000 as part of the UCD-OFM (Orders of Friars Minor) Partnership which also initiated the transfer of the priceless Irish Franciscan archive to University College Dublin. The Institute supports researchers and promotes Irish studies through conferences, seminars and publications.

The Mícheál Ó Cléirigh Prize will be awarded to the best graduate paper submitted to, and delivered at, the ICM. The winning entrant will receive a prize of €100 and will be offered the chance to publish in *Peritia*, the Journal of the Medieval Academy of Ireland. The adjudicating panel will be the ICM Committee in consultation with the editors of *Peritia*. The following terms and conditions apply:

- All graduates currently registered for a degree at a recognised Third Level institution are eligible.
- Papers should be submitted to <u>icm2015@ucd.ie</u> no later than 5pm Monday June 15<sup>th</sup>. PDF or Word formats are preferable.
- Papers should not normally exceed 5000 words in length, including footnotes.
